1 – UK Woodland Carbon Code

Overview:

- UK's government-backed standard for woodland carbon projects, allowing for the generation of "carbon credits"
- Helps companies to become:
 - Net Zero
 - Carbon Neutral
 - Lifetime Carbon Neutral
 - Carbon Negative
 - Lifetime Carbon Negative

Generation of Credits:

- One tonne of CO₂e
- Pending Issuance Units PIUs
- Woodland Carbon Units WCUs













- 1. NEW WOODLAND CREATION
 ONLY
- 2. No minimum/maximum area
- Can also include Natural Regeneration
- 4. Hedgerows not yet included
- 5. Must be *additional*

- 1. Replant in case of catastrophe
- 2. Verify every 10 years
- Manage project as outlined in initial carbon calculations/ management plan
- 4. Manage to UKFS

5 – How to Sell Carbon Units

How much money can be made?

Prices currently range from £10/unit to £30+/unit.

Number of units generated range from 100 units/ha to 500 units/ha.

So total can be anywhere from £1,000/ha to £15,000+/ha.

- 3. Vintage of units

- 4. Flexibility
- 5. Stage of Project
- 6. Associated Benefits





5 – How to Sell Carbon Units

- 1. You can sell both PIUs and WCUs
- 2. Can sell anytime, in any quantity
- 3. Depends on 'vintage'
- Sell to anybody looking to offset their
 UK-based emissions
- 5. Annual Payments
- 6. Automated Sales
- 7. Bundle/Stack with other credits/grants
- Woodland Carbon Guarantee





6 - Current Market

- 1. 1,326 (1,176) Projects registered under the WCC, of which 330 (309) are validated
- 2. This equates to *49,874* (44,696) hectares of new woodland creation overall, *16,921* (16,116) hectares of which is validated
- 3. Expected to sequester 16.9 million tonnes
 CO₂e (15.4 million) over their lifetime, of which
 6.3 million tonnes (6.1 million) is validated
- 4. **3,299,000** (3,177,000) units have been sold, with **1,434,000** (1,448,000) left available for sale
