# **Defra Funding Announcements**

The NFU Conference brought a raft of announcements by the Secretary of State. These include:

- Increasing a number of HLS payment rates in existing agreements.
- Capital Grants will be running for the 2025/2026 year and will be open for applications in the spring/summer
- Other announcements include Farming in Protected Landscapes (FiPL) programme has been extended by a further year.

**Bluetongue Risk - Be Aware** 

The Bluetongue restricted zone has moved closer to Dartmoor following cases in Somerset and Devon during February. Vaccinations are available, although not subsidised this year. It is worth keeping an eye on the gov.uk page which lists the contact details if you suspect a case as well as updates on the restricted zone and requirements if moving animals across the zone.

**APHA Conference** 

We were recently invited to speak at the Animal Health and Plant Agency's national Ruminant Health Day in Plymouth. Our joint presentation with Ann Willcocks from Harford and Ugborough Commons Association covered key findings for the Healthy Livestock Project over the past three years. The conference looked at collaborative approaches in shared space grazing with some interesting speakers covering topics from tick borne disease and sheep scab to unexplained lamb losses in Scottish hill flocks. We also held a group session for staff and graziers in the three Landscape Recovery projects on Dartmoor exploring the opportunities to support animal health in scheme design.

In February we hosted a visit from 25 Bodmin Moor Commoners organised through the Cornwall National Landscape Farming in Protected Landscapes Team. It was a particularly wet day on Dartmoor but we managed to visit three great farms and a common allowing discussion on topics such as mental health, animal health, commons governance and Molinia management.
